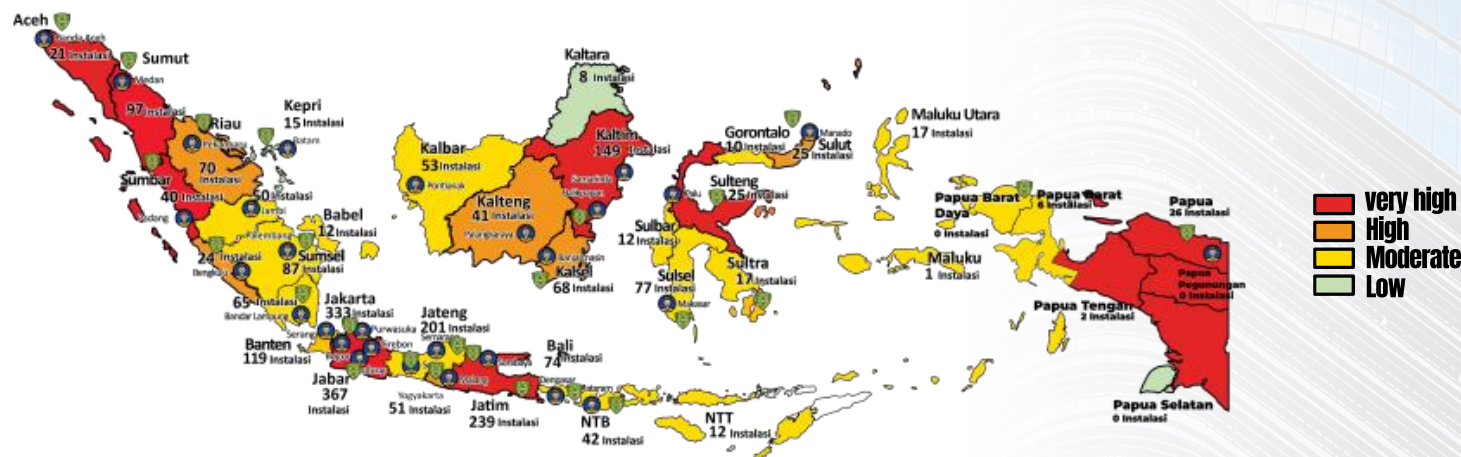
Why is it relevant for cities?

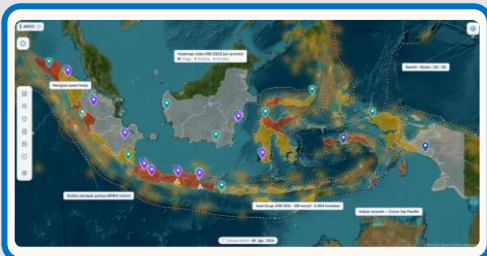

IoT-based Early Warning System

Devices are developed to strengthen community preparedness for floods and earthquakes.



Indonesia Rescue Summit (IRS)
Builds emergency response competencies through training, competition and government partnership



Indonesia Disaster Management Summit (IDMS)
Strategic forum to strengthen multi-stakeholder collaboration and report outcomes to national leadership
