# Clear Responsibilities Enable Strong Disaster Response

Under TAMP, each municipal unit assumes critical responsibilities at a different stage of a disaster.



## DEPARTMENT OF DISASTER AFFAIRS AND RISK MANAGEMENT

Leads coordination among municipal units during disasters and emergencies.

## FIRE DEPARTMENT

Leads firefighting, search and rescue, and field operations.

## CEMETERIES BRANCH DIRECTORATE

Provides burial services and institutional support for identification procedures.

## SOCIAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT

Assesses needs and prioritizes hot meals, essential aid, and support for vulnerable groups.

## SHARED OBJECTIVE

A coordinated response that protects lives, meets essential needs rapidly, and maintains service continuity.

The municipality’s people, vehicles, equipment, and infrastructure enable a strong, coordinated disaster response.

## 3 BUILD A SHARED RISK DATABASE

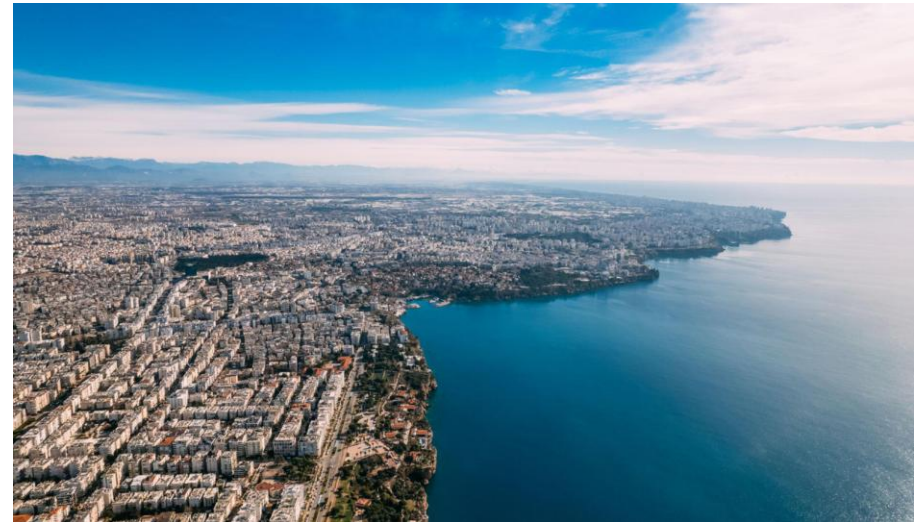
Integrate district-level multi-hazard and critical infrastructure data.
