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FROM LESSONS TO ACTIONS

- One citizen, Two plants (post-cyclone recovery initiative)
- Youth Climate Action Fund (Grassroot organizations were given the responsibility to identify priority areas)
- Empowering Local committees for disaster risk management (preparedness and early warning)
- Public-private-partnership (ZAMVIS ã O- master plan design)



INSTITUTIONALIZING DRR

- Local/Municipal committees for DRR (every departments understand the need of including DRR on their planning)
- Updated HAZARD Map known by all stakeholders including LCDRM
- Accountability (Investments and results are monitored and reported)



Reflections

- Resilience financing should not begin when disaster strikes;
- Vulnerable cities do not only need more money for resilience : capacity building and knowledge transfer shall be priority.
- Cities are all invited to design a FINANCING ROADMAP for DRR
- Risk information » planning » prioritization » Design » Financing » implementation » Monitoring
